

What is an MDF?

It's where your phone/adsl service connects to the network

This is an average MDF in an apartment building or unit complex.

This MDF holds 50 'pairs' on the Telstra network side.

These 'pairs' are connected via the black cabling to the local exchange.

This black cabling indicates the Network Boundary for your network provider.

Telstra will "tag" the network side once your phone/adsl service is connected to this point, identifying your line/s.

Only a licensed technician with an OPEN Cabling Registration can work on your MDF.

From here the cabling connects to a smaller MDF called an IDF located closer to your apartment or unit.

The IDF then connects your phone/adsl service to the line/s located in your home or business.
